



EnviroSolutions, Inc. to be Honored by CSX for “Green” Shipping Practices
Reduced 2008 Carbon Emissions by 11,000 Tons through Freight Rail

April 22, 2009 – Manassas, VA. EnviroSolutions, Inc. today announced that it is a recipient of CSX Transportation’s (CSXT) first-ever Environmental Award. The award will be conferred upon EnviroSolutions at the CSX Environmental Awards dinner to be held in Jacksonville, Florida on April 23 for its sustainable transportation practices.

CSXT is recognizing its freight railroad customers whose sustainable shipping practices help to significantly reduce carbon emissions. In 2008, EnviroSolutions reduced carbon emissions by 11,000 tons by shipping almost 400,000 tons of solid waste on CSXT freight rail. In addition, by choosing to ship via rail, EnviroSolutions also alleviates congestion on the roads and conserve fossil fuels.

EnviroSolutions is one of 19 CSXT customers who, together in 2008 avoided over 1.2 million tons of carbon emissions by shipping with CSXT versus the highway alternative. These customers are being recognized because they either led their industry in 2008 using CSXT to reduce their freight emissions or showed the greatest improvement in emissions efficiency in 2008 compared to 2007. “CSXT is pleased to honor EnviroSolutions with this award,” said Clarence W. Gooden, Executive Vice President - Sales and Marketing and Chief Commercial Officer, CSX. “Shipping via freight rail is the most environmentally-friendly mode of surface transportation; one train is as efficient as 280 trucks, and can haul a ton of freight more than 436 miles on a single gallon of fuel,” Gooden added.
